INTRODUCTION

Dear colleague,

It is our pleasure to present the 4th edition of the OPL Web Guide.

In addition to the services described in previous versions (creating your institutional e-mail (OPL e-mail), your secure account, your e-Library account, and using Swank to earn online credits), this guide will help you use the new platforms developed by the OPL:

- **The Medication Safety platform** which allows you to report adverse reactions related to any drug or product administered to a patient in a community or hospital setting. The aim is to create a standardized assessment system, reporting objectively any reaction based on a reliable and reproducible measurement of causality.
- **The Lebanese Advanced Patient Profile (LAPP) platform** which is used to apply the unified prescription and create an advanced electronic patient profile. This will also serve to manage patients' medication and therapy, using the principle of Medication Therapy Management (MTM) and Medication Utilization Review (MUR). It will also facilitate linking the patients with third-party payers.
